New block for Angley School in Cranbrook 03/08/07

Lee Evans Partnership has just completed The Harris Centre, a new purpose-built facility for Angley School, in Cranbrook, Kent. The new £1.5m Harris Centre provides an exciting glimpse into future developments for the school and their plans to renew and develop purpose built modern facilities. The accommodation includes changing rooms, a seminar room and a classroom with ICT connections on the ground floor and 2 further classrooms on the first floor which can be combined into one large space for larger events/teaching sessions. The modern materials used in construction have been carefully selected to be hardwearing and maintenance free. Highly glazed the new building has integral blinds in glass which have a life-time guarantee. As essentially a pre-phase development for the new campus it was important that the design of the building was highly flexible. All internal partitions are light weight metal stud work which can be easily reconfigured to adapt to changes in the school curriculum or suit the school's future accommodation requirements, when the campus is redeveloped. Its modular construction also means that additional accommodation can be easily added and Planning Consent has already been approved in principle for a Phase 2 development of 2 further classrooms and another seminar room.
