Inaugural photographic competition huge success 15/11/07

Staff at Lee Evans Partnership were invited to take part in the practice's first ever in-house photography competition. The three categories, Life in Motion, The Figure in the Built Environment and Light and Shade attracted over 50 entries.

Chair of judges, professional architectural photographer, Robert Greshoff, was impressed with the standard of the entries and also praised the technical quality, composition and breadth of subject matter demonstrated.
