Phase 1 and 2 of major redevelopment programme complete at Central Sussex College's Haywards Heath campus

Lee Evans Partnership has just finished Phase 1 and 2 of a major 3 phase £29m redevelopment of Central Sussex College's Haywards Heath campus which when complete will provide the best facilities of their kind in the area.

£9.8million has been invested in Phase 1 to provide state-of-the-art performing arts facilities. Students previously accustomed to temporary accommodation with poor acoustics and busing to performance venues now have 'The Hub', an impressive theatre space with seating for 260, two rehearsal studios and two dance studios. In addition there is a music performance suite which has been designed in collaboration with the Brighton Institute of Modern Music (BIMM). Phase 1 also provides two digital language laboratories and modern language classrooms, IT rooms and office space.

The new £4m Phase 2 wing offers superb facilities for the College's media and visual arts students with studios for art, design and photography, a dark room, digital photography suite plus new film and media labs.

Completion of Phase 2 now gives the College sufficient classrooms to allow for the demolition of part of the existing buildings which will start in August 2008. Phase 3 is due to commence on site in October and when completed will provide a hair salon and communal student facilities including a coffee shop, canteen, student support services, learning resources and a library. This substantial three-storey project will also provide further classrooms, science laboratories and IT suites plus a complete new forecourt, sports hall and leisure facilities.
