Weald of Kent Grammar School for Girls opens new block – 20/09/06

An exciting new English & Humanities block, Phase 1 of a 2-phase programme, which is designed to provide a flexible working environment for the highly successful Weald of Kent Grammar School for Girls in Tonbridge, was opened by Paul Carter, Leader of Kent County Council on Wednesday, 20 September 2006.

Lee Evans Partnership was appointed as the architects after winning a competition to design the new accommodation.

The project is part of KCC's county-wide improvement programme, designed to rid schools of poor quality, temporary teaching spaces.

Head Teacher, Sue Rowell, thanked all the individuals and organisation who had contributed to the success of the project and said, ' Students and staff are delighted with the new facilities which I know will benefit and enhance student learning.'

With a roll of 1,070 girls, the school enjoys language college status and the new building provides 16 much needed new classrooms, which include a media studies classroom and editing suite. In addition the new car park on the lower sports field offers parking for a further 37 cars.

Phase 2, new Art and Drama facilities, is currently awaiting Planning Permission.
